## GAIN POINTS

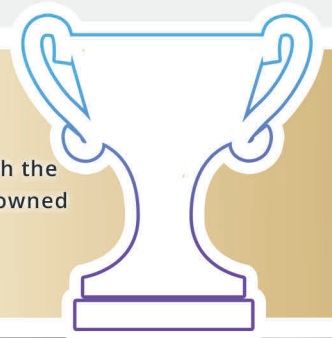
Accumulate UK series points 3 different ways;

- Achieve a top 10 place in the single-run shootout (table 1)
- Achieve a top 5 place in any of the 4 series rounds at each heat (table 2)
- Achieve a top 5 place in the Iconix Agility By Night Finals (see next page)

## BECOME CHAMPION

After all series heats are completed, the dog and handler partnership with the most points in their respective competition and height category will be crowned 'Iconix UK Series Champion'





## SERIES HEAT COMPETITION FORMAT

All rounds are KC Open progression classes, the series format uses the results from these classes. If you miss the 'cut' or 'final cut' you still compete in your entered classes as standard KC progression classes.

4 series rounds across the weekend, 2 per day (1 Agility and 1 Jumping)

Cumulative results after first 2 rounds on day 1 rank all competitors, the top 75% (rounded up) of dog and handler partnerships make the 'cut' and proceed to round 3 on day 2.

Following round 3 on day 2, cumulative results of remaining competitors will see a 'final cut' made. The top 50% (OR a maximum of 50 partnerships) make the 'final cut' and proceed to the single-run shootout.

Round 4 on day 2 is the single-run shootout. Those dog and handler partnerships that made the 'cut' & 'final cut' compete in round 4. Results from the single-run shootout alone dictate the series heat points allocation.

## MUST COMPETE TWO

You must compete in at least 2 Iconix Agility UK series heats during the season to be named the Iconix Agility UK Champion. There is no limit to how many you can count.

## OTHER POINTS SCORING OPPORTUNITY

Iconix Agility By Night also has point scoring potential. Make it through to the evening finals and finish in the top 5 in your competition category to accumulate further Iconix UK Series points (table 3).
